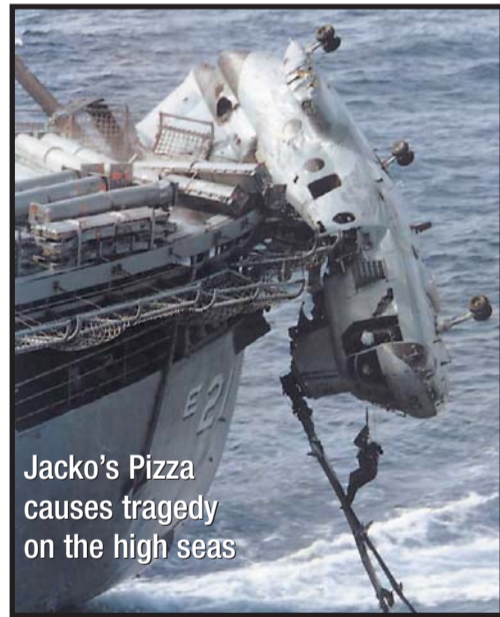


well with the guys when he was at work, but was a recluse who spent most of his time in the casino's and on golf courses in and around Varese and Milan."

Giancarla Mozzarella speaking on behalf of AgustaWestland said "Keith was an OK bloke, he got on

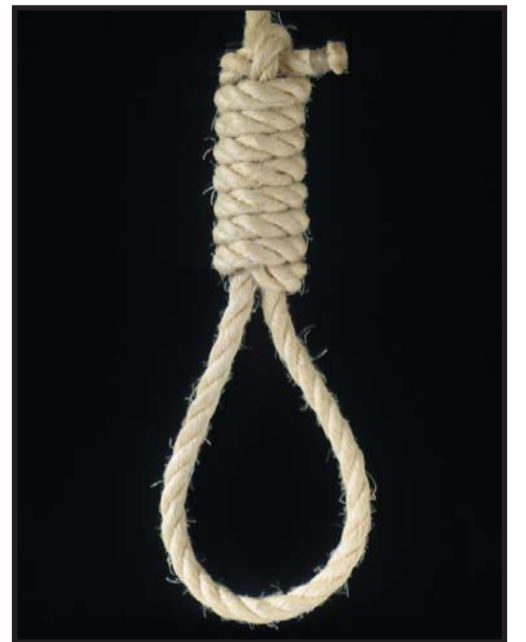
FIVE PLAYERS ON SUICIDE WATCH

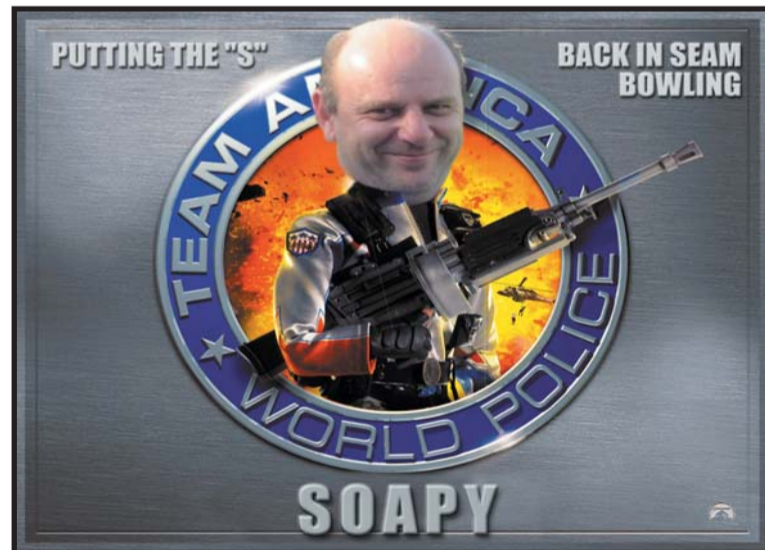

Soapy has already done the photo-shoot for the publicity material set to adorn poster sites up and down the country.

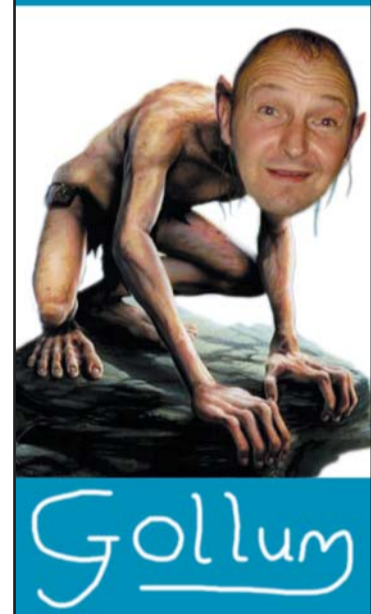
