BELVEDERE PLAYER SPOTTED IN SAND BAY

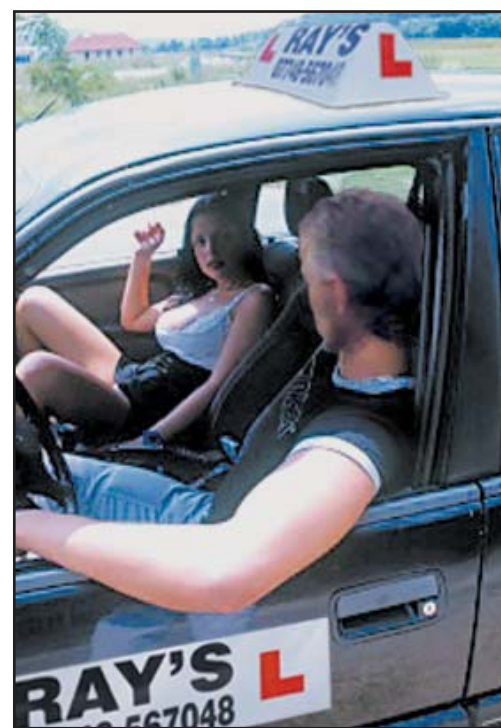
